1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO EXPAND THE PROHIBITION ON OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A 3 PASSING LANE AT LESS THAN THE SPEED LIMIT OR WHEN IMPEDING THE 4 STEADY FLOW OF TRAFFIC AND TO INCREASE THE MONETARY PENALTY 5 FOR COMMITTING A VIOLATION OF THAT PROHIBITION. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-146 reads as rewritten: 8 "§ 20-146. Drive on right side of highway; exceptions. 9 10 (b) Upon all highwayshighways, any vehicle proceeding at less than the legal maximum 11 speed limit or impeding the steady flow of traffic shall be driven in the right-hand lane then 12 available for thru traffic, or as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the highway, except when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction 13 14 or when preparing for a left turn.a lane other than the inside lane next to the centerline or 15 median of a multi-lane highway, except when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when making a left turn. A person who violates this 16 subsection is guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200.00). For 17 purposes of this subsection, a person is "impeding the steady flow of traffic" if the person 18 19 knows or reasonably should know that he or she is being overtaken from the rear by a vehicle 20 traveling at a higher rate of speed. 21 . . . 22 (e) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, when appropriate signs have 23 been posted, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle over and upon the inside lane, next to the median of any dual-lane highway at a speed less than the posted speed 24 25 limit when the operation of said motor vehicle over and upon said inside lane shall impede the steady flow of traffic except when preparing for a left turn. "Appropriate signs" as used herein 26 27 shall be construed as including "Slower Traffic Keep Right" or designations of similar import." 28 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2015, and applies to

29 offenses committed on or after that date.
