

5	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-20.1 reads as rewritten:				
6	"(c) Compliance Period Upon petition to the court, the judge may determine the				
7	effective date of the limited privilege, and the effective date shall be stated on the face of the				
8	order. The following table sets out the period during which a person must comply with a				
9	revocation under G.S. 20-28(a) or G.S. 20-28.1 to be eligible for a limited driving privilege				
10	under this section:

16		m of a limited driving privilege issued under this			
17	section is the shorter of for a one year <u>one-year</u> or the length of time remaining in the revocation				
18	period imposed under G.S. 20-28(a) or G.S. 20-28.1. period. At the end of the term, the				
19	petitioner may petition the court for an additional one-year term, and upon review of the				
20	petitioner's current driving record and criminal history, the court may reissue the limited				
21	privilege for an additional one-year term. The decision to extend the petitioner's limited driving				
22	privilege for an additional term is in the discretion of the court. The limited privilege can be				
23	<u>renewed only twice.</u> When the term of the limited driving privilege expires, the Division must				
24	reinstate the person's license if the person meets all of the conditions listed in this subsection.				
25	The Division may impose restrictions or conditions on the new license in accordance with				
26	G.S. 20-7(e). The conditions are:
