19	petitioner may petition the court for an additional one-year term, and upon review of the				
20	petitioner's current driving record and criminal history, the court may reissue the limited				
21	privilege for an additional one-year term. The decision to extend the petitioner's limited driving				
22	privilege for an additional term is in the discretion of the court. The limited privilege can be				
23	<u>renewed only twice.</u> When the term of the limited driving privilege expires, the Division must reinstate the person's license if the person meets all of the conditions listed in this subsection.
