## **General Assembly Of North Carolina**

1 **SECTION 1.4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 2 Public Instruction the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2016-2017 fiscal 3 year for administration of the LAPT program and evaluation by an independent research 4 organization.

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**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
