SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Reserve for Compensation Increases the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2016-2017 fiscal year to fund increases in State employee compensation required by compliance with the twelve dollar (\$12.00) per hour minimum wage required by this section.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
