5	Whereas, Henson P. Barnes was educated at Garland High School, Wilmingtor
5	College, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, where he received a Bachelor of Arts
7	degree in 1959 and a Juris Doctor degree in 1961; and
3	Whereas, Henson P. Barnes proudly served his country in the United States Army as a
)	paratrooper from 1953 to 1956 and, for his distinguished service, received citations and letters or
)	commendation from battalion, regimental, and divisional Commands; and
l	Whereas, Henson P. Barnes was a successful attorney and farmer; and

7	General Assembly in the House of Representatives from 1975 to 1976 and in the Senate from
