1	A JOINT RESOLUTION URGING THE RELEASE OF PASTOR ANDREW BRUNSON
2	FROM A TURKISH PRISON.
3	Whereas, Pastor Andrew Brunson is an American citizen and from Black Mountain,
4 5	North Carolina, who has served as a missionary and pastor in Turkey since 1993; and Whereas, Pastor Brunson was detained and formally arrested following the Turkish
6	government's imposition of a State of Emergency after a violent coup attempt in July 2016 that
7	was rightly opposed by the United States and Turks from across the political spectrum; and
8	Was rightly opposed by the officed states and ranks from deross the pointed spectrum, and Whereas, during the State of Emergency, tens of thousands of citizens of Turkey and
9	citizens of the United States were arrested on vague criminal charges based on false evidence;
10	and
11	Whereas, the Turkish government detained Pastor Brunson in 2016 without issuing
12	an indictment until March of 2018; and
13	Whereas, Pastor Brunson faces a possible sentence of 35 years for being involved in
14	a "terrorist organization," while merely being a Christian pastor and missionary in Turkey; and
15	Whereas, Pastor Brunson's next hearing date is July 18, 2018, at which time he will
16	have spent 649 days of his life away from his family, including his wife and two daughters, in a
17	Turkish prison on wrongful and unfair charges; and
18	Whereas, Foreign Minister Cavusoglu stated, "What needs to be done is the United
19	States needs to let go of this"; and
20	Whereas, 66 bipartisan members of the United States Senate and 154 bipartisan
21	members of the United States House of Representatives signed separate letters to Recep Tayyip
22	Erdoğan, President of the Republic of Turkey, urging him to release Pastor Brunson; and
23	Whereas, Turkey and the United States are both members of the North Atlantic Treaty
24	Organization; and
25 26	Whereas, Turkey's ongoing policy of unlawfully detaining United States citizens
26 27	significantly damages economic and diplomatic cooperation and undermines the long-standing
27	trust between our State and country rooted in NATO principles; Now, therefore, Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:
28 29	SECTION 1. The General Assembly joins members of the United States Congress
29 30	in asking that Pastor Brunson be released from prison immediately.
31	SECTION 2. The General Assembly encourages Congress and the Trump
32	Administration to take necessary steps to protect the interests of American citizens in Turkey,
33	including with sanctions and other appropriate means.
34	SECTION 3. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
35	to the members of North Carolina's congressional delegation.
36	SECTION 4. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
