A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE BURDEN OF PROOF IN CERTAIN CHALLENGES TO

3 CANDIDACY BE PLACED ON THE CHALLENGER UNDER THE LAWS4 GOVERNING ELECTIONS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 163A-1029(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) The Except for a challenge based on residency as provided in subsection (b) of this 8 section, the burden of proof shall be upon the candidate, challenger, who must show by a

9 preponderance of the evidence of the record as a whole that he or she is the candidate is not qualified to be a candidate for the office."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to challenges to
candidacy on or after that date.
