The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105-333(12) reads as rewritten: "§ 105-333. Definitions. The following definitions apply in this Article unless the context requires a different meaning:

energy to electricity shall be treated as nonsystem property." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2017, and applies to taxes imposed for taxable years beginning on or after that date.

Nonsystem property. – The real and tangible personal property owned by a public service company but not used in its public service activities. <u>Real and</u>
