SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-301.1(p) reads as rewritten:

Prior to the entry of any order of the court in a criminal case, the court shall attempt to (p) identify all outstanding warrants against that individual individual, if in custody, and notify the appropriate law enforcement agencies of the location of the individual."
