6	The General Asse	embly of North Carolina enacts:	
7	SECT	<b>ION 1.</b> Findings. – The General Assembly finds the following:	
8	(1)	The Tennessee Valley Authority and the State entered into a Memorandum of	
9		Agreement, dated July 30, 1943 (1943 Agreement).	
10	(2)	As part of the 1943 Agreement, the United States Department of the Interior	
11		committed to "construct or cause to be constructed" a road that was to run from	
12		the eastern boundary of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park to the	
13		Fontana Dam Access Road. This road is commonly referred to as the "North	
14		Shore Road."	
15	(3)	The North Shore Road has never been fully constructed.	
16	(4)	The Tennessee Valley Authority and the State entered into another	
17		Memorandum of Agreement, dated February 6, 2010 (2010 Agreement).	
18	(5)	As part of the 2010 Agreement, the federal government agreed to pay (i) eight	
19		million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$8,800,000) within 130 days of the date	
20		the 2010 Agreement was executed and (ii) additional sums not to exceed	
21		thirty-nine million two hundred thousand dollars (\$39,200,000) on or before	
22		December 31, 2020, to Swain County, North Carolina, to settle any and all	
23		claims related to the United State Department of the Interior's failure to fully	
24		construct the North Shore Road.	
25	(6)	Swain County still has not received any of the additional sums owed to it under	
26	<b>GEOT</b>	the 2010 Agreement.	
27		<b>ION 2.</b> Investigation. – The Attorney General shall investigate any legal	
28		e to Swain County and the State to ensure payment by the federal government of	
29	the remaining sums of money owed to Swain County under the 2010 Agreement.		
30	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Report. – The Attorney General shall report its findings, including any		
31 32	legislative recommendations, to the General Assembly by June 1, 2017. The report required under this section shall be submitted in accordance with G.S. 120-29.5.		
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55	SECI	<b>ION 4.</b> Effective Date. – This act is effective when it becomes law.
