- 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION TO STUDY 3 RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCARDED COMPUTER EQUIPMENT AND 4
 - TELEVISIONS IN THE STATE.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. The Environmental Review Commission shall study North Carolina's recycling requirements for discarded computer equipment and televisions. In conducting this 7 study, the Commission shall consider (i) the changing waste stream, including the transition from 8 televisions containing cathode ray tubes to flat screen televisions; (ii) the current status of North 9 Carolina's recycling system, including markets, and cost and financing issues; (iii) additional 10 options for disposal of electronic products; and (iv) any other issue the Commission deems 11 relevant. The Environmental Review Commission shall report its findings and recommendations, 12 13 including any legislative proposals, to the 2018 Regular Session of the 2017 General Assembly 14 upon its convening. 15

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
