4	APPARATUS, SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, OR EQUIPMENT INVOLVING THE				
5	EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC FUNDS, GIVE PREFERENCE TO LOCAL BIDDERS				
6	AND LOCAL RESIDENTS WHEN CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.				
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
8	SECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended	1 by			
9	adding a new section to read as follows:	2			
10	"§ 143-131.2. Local contract preference.				
11	(a) Bid-Match Preference. – Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, w	hen			
12	contracting for construction or repair work or for the purchase of apparatus, supplies, materials,				
13	or equipment involving the expenditure of public funds, counties and municipalities may give				
14	preference to the lowest responsible, responsive local bidder if the following conditions	are			
15	met: (i) the bid of the lowest responsible, responsive local bidder is no greater than five percent				
16	(5%) or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), whichever is less, of the bid of the lowest responsible.				
17	responsive nonlocal bidder and (ii) the lowest responsible, responsive local bidder matches the				
18	bid of the lowest responsible, responsive nonlocal bidder.				
19	(b) Contractor Responsibilities. – A local or nonlocal bidder who is awarded a con				
20	with a county or municipality under subsection (a) of this section shall give preference to I				
21	businesses and local residents. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a contractor				
22	to award contracts or subcontracts to or to make purchases of apparatus, supplies, material				
23	equipment from a local business that does not submit the lowest responsible, responsive b				
24	bids or to employ a local resident who does not meet the contractor's qualifications				
25	employment. Within 30 days of being awarded a contract, the contractor shall submit to				
26	governing body or a person designated by the governing body, a Community Preference				
27	which shall identify (i) the local businesses and local residents that the contractor will use on				
28	the project, (ii) the good-faith efforts the contractor has made to contact local businesses that				
29	reasonably could have been expected to submit a quote, (iii) the good-faith efforts the				
30	contractor has made to employ qualified local residents, and (iv) the estimated total dollar value				
31	of the contract that will be performed by local businesses.
