Short Title: Study Expunctions Related to 50B Orders. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: April 13, 2017 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO STUDY WHETHER A DEFENDANT IN A 50B ACTION SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO EXPUNGE ORDERS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE ACTION IN SOME CIRCUMSTANCES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety shall study the issue of whether a defendant in a 50B action should be allowed to expunge orders and other documents related to the action and under what circumstances any expunction should be allowed. The Committee shall consider the following: Expunction when an ex parte or temporary order is issued, but a subsequent (1) voluntary dismissal is filed or taken in favor of the defendant by the plaintiff. Expunction when an ex parte or temporary order is issued, but after a (2) hearing or other regular court proceeding where evidence is presented by one or both parties, the court finds that the defendant did not commit acts of domestic violence. When a domestic violence protective order has been entered, whether there (3) are conditions a defendant could meet to warrant expunction of the order after some period of time with no additional incidents of domestic violence, violent behavior, or substance or alcohol abuse. **(4)** Any other relevant issue.
