7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 18C-162 reads as rewritten:		
9	"§ 18C-162. Allocation of revenues.		
10	(a) Th	he Commission shall allocate revenues to the North Carolina State Lotter	y Fund in
11	order to increase and maximize the available revenues for education purposes, and to the extent		
12	practicable, shall adhere to the following guidelines:		
13	(1)) At least fifty percent (50%) of the total annual revenues, as describ	ed in this
14		Chapter, shall be returned to the public in the form of prizes.	
15	(2) At least thirty-five percent (35%) of the total annual revenues, as dea	scribed in
16		this Chapter, shall be transferred as provided in G.S. 18C-164.	
17	(3) No more than eight percent (8%) of the total annual revenues, as dea	scribed in
18		this Chapter, shall be allocated for payment of expenses of the	Lottery.
19		Advertising expenses shall not exceed one percent (1%) of the tot	al annual
20		revenues.	
21	(4) No more than seven percent (7%) of the face value of tickets or s	shares, as
22		described in this Chapter, shall be allocated for compensation paid	to lottery
23		game retailers.	
24	<u>(a1)</u> <u>A</u>	dvertising costs shall not exceed two percent (2%) of the total annual rev	venues, as
25	described in this Chapter.
