If flags are donated or are otherwise available, flags shall be displayed in each classroom." 46 47 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the 48 General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars 49 (\$25,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2018-2019 fiscal year to implement the requirements of

this act, including to fund the purchase of supplies for students to create displays or to fund the

purchase of mounted plaques.

SECTION 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 2018, and applies beginning December 1, 2018.
