15 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section 16 to read:

17 "§ 145-49. Fried chicken festival.

18 The Fried Chicken Festival, held the third weekend of May of every year in the City of 19 Fayetteville, is adopted as the official fried chicken festival of the State of North Carolina."

20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
