The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 116-11 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
"(7b) The Board of Governors shall adopt a policy that allows individuals who are		
65 years of age or older to audit up to six hours of undergraduate level		
classes per semester at a constituent institution, provided the class is not full		
and the faculty member approves the request. Attendance by audit shall not		
be counted as full-time equivalent student hours."		
<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 115D-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
" <u>(b2)</u> N	lotwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, the State Board of Con	<u>ımunity</u>
Colleges shall adopt a policy that allows individuals who are 65 years of age or older to audit		
up to six hours of curricular courses per semester at a community college, provided the class is		
not full and the faculty member approves the request. Attendance by audit shall not be counted		
as full-time equivalent student hours."		
<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2017, and applies to the 2018 fall		
academic semester and each subsequent academic semester.
