S	ECTION 1. G.S. 93E-2-4(i) reads as rewritten:
"(i) F	or appraisal assignments of property secured by the principal dwelling of the
consumer, one- to four-family residential dwellings, an appraisal management company shall	
compensate appraisers in compliance with section 129E(i) of the federal Truth in Lending Act	
(15 U.S.C. § 1601 et seq.) and regulations promulgated thereunder. The Board shall adopt rules	
necessary to enforce this subsection. Rules establishing customary and reasonable rates shall be	
based on objective third-party information, such as academic studies and independent private	
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SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2017.
