SESSION LAW 2018-137 SENATE BILL 820

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE PER JOB CAP FOR PURPOSES OF CERTAIN JOB DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE GRANT AWARDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-437.56(f) reads as rewritten:

"(f) For projects other than transformative projects, the amount of a grant associated with any specific eligible position, including any amount transferred to the Utility Account pursuant to G.S. 143B-437.61, may not exceed six thousand five hundred dollars (\$6,500)sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) in any year."

SECTION 2. G.S. 143B-437.57(a)(23) reads as rewritten:

"(23) For projects other than transformative projects, a provision stating that the amount of a grant associated with any specific eligible position, including any amount transferred to the Utility Account pursuant to G.S. 143B-437.61, may not exceed six thousand five hundred dollars (\$6,500) the limitation contained in subdivision (f) of G.S. 143B-437.56 in any year."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to awards granted on or after that date.
