A HOUSE RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2019 HOUSE PERMANENT RULES TO REQUIRE VETO OVERRIDE VOTES BE HELD BY A TIME CERTAIN.

SECTION 1. Rule 44.2 of the 2019 House Permanent Rules, as contained in House Resolution 16, as enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the 2019 General Assembly, reads as rewritten:

"RULE 44.2. **Veto Override.** – (a) Other than in a reconvened session, no vote shall be taken on overriding a gubernatorial veto on a House bill until the second legislative day following notice of its placement on the calendar.

- (b) Other than in a reconvened session, no vote shall be taken on overriding a gubernatorial veto on a Senate bill until the legislative day following notice of its placement on the calendar.
- (c) <u>In all circumstances</u>, a vote to override a gubernatorial veto on a House or a Senate bill shall be taken within five legislative days following notice of its placement on the calendar." **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
