Remedies not exclusive. 8 The remedies provided by this Chapter are not exclusive but are additional to 9 remedies provided under Chapter 50 and elsewhere in the General Statutes. Any subsequent court order entered supersedes similar provisions related to child 10 custody, child and spousal support, and possession of property issued under Chapter 50 or 11 12 Chapter 110 supersedes similar provisions in protective orders issued pursuant to this Chapter." 13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2020, and applies to orders in 14

effect on or after that date.
