2 SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors 3 4 of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be allocated to The Friday Institute for 5 Educational Innovation at North Carolina State University to conduct the study required by 6 7 Section 1 of this act.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
