2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TITLE AND REGISTRATION OF MODIFIED UTILITY				
3	VEHICLES FOR USE ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS.				
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-4.01(27) is amended by adding a new sub-subdivision to read:				
6	"g2. Modified utility vehicle. – A motor vehicle that is (i) designed for				
7	off-road use and (ii) manufactured with equipment required by				
8	G.S. 20-121.1(2). "Modified utility vehicle" does not include an				
9	all-terrain vehicle, golf cart, or utility vehicle, as defined in this				
10	section, or a riding lawn mower."				
11	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 20-87(12) reads as rewritten:				
12	"(12) Low-Speed Vehicles and Mini-Trucks. Vehicles, Mini-Trucks, and Modified				
13	<u>Utility Vehicles.</u> – The fee for a low-speed vehicle or mini-truck-vehicle,				
14	mini-truck, or modified utility vehicle is the same as the fee for private				
15	passenger vehicles of not more than 15 passengers. However, the fee for any				
16	low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility				
17	vehicle that is offered for rent shall be the same as the fee for a U-drive-it				
18	automobile."				
19	SECTION 3. G.S. 20-121.1 reads as rewritten:				
20	"§ 20-121.1. Operation of a low-speed vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified				
21	<u>utility vehicle</u> on certain roadways.				
22	The operation of a low-speed vehicle or mini truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility				
23	<u>vehicle</u> is authorized with the following restrictions:				
24	(1) A low-speed vehicle may be operated only on streets and highways where the				
25 26	posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or less. <u>A modified utility vehicle may</u>				
26 27	be operated only on streets and highways where the posted speed limit is 55				
27 28	<u>miles per hour or less.</u> A mini-truck may be operated only on streets and highways where the posted speed limit is 55 miles per hour or less. This does				
28 29					
29 30	not prohibit a low-speed <del>vehicle or mini-truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified</del> <u>utility vehicle from crossing a road or street at an intersection where the road</u>				
30 31	or street being crossed has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour.				
31	(2) A low-speed vehicle or mini truck vehicle, mini-truck, or modified utility				
32	vehicle shall be equipped with headlamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, tail				
33 34	lamps, reflex reflectors, parking brakes, rearview mirrors, windshields,				
35	windshield wipers, speedometer, seat belts, and a vehicle identification

7		vehicles or mini-trucks-vehicles, mini-trucks, or modified u	tility vehicles on
8		any road or highway if it determines that the prohibition is	necessary in the
9		interest of safety.	
10	(5)	Low-speed vehicles must comply with the safety standard	s in 49 C.F.R. §
11		571.500.	
12	(6)	Regardless of age, a mini-truck shall not qualify as an ar	ntique vehicle or
13		historic vehicle as described in G.S. 20-79.4(b)."	
14	SECT	<b>TON 4.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
