9 hundred thousand dollars (\$13,200,000) for the 2020-2021 fiscal year from the Con	onavirus
10 Relief Reserve established under Section 2.1 of S.L. 2020-4 to the Coronavirus Relief Fu	nd under
11 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act of 2020, P.L.	116-136,
12 established in Section 2.2 of that act.	
13 SECTION 1.(b) There is appropriated from the Coronavirus Relief Fun	nd to the
14 Department of Health and Human Services (Department) the sum of thirteen million two	hundred
15 thousand dollars (\$13,200,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to) provide
16 additional assistance to eligible recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families	(TANF)
17 benefits in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Department shall allocate up to tw	o million
18 two hundred thousand dollars (\$2,200,000) per month for payments to eligible recipier	nts. Each
19 eligible recipient shall receive a monthly payment of one hundred ninety-three dollars (\$193.00)
20 for up to six months pursuant to this section.

23 SECTION 2. The Department of Health and Human Services shall provide	e a report

26 March 1, 2021, detailing the use of funds allocated under this act.	
27 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2020, and applies retroad	tively to
assistance provided on or after March 1, 2020, and expires December 30, 2020.
