| 3        | AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT FUNDS TO THE STATE  |
| 4        | BOARD OF ELECTIONS FOR THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION IN RESPONSE TO  |
| 5        | THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC.  |
| 6        | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:   |
| 7        | SECTION 1.(a) There is appropriated the sum of eleven million six hundred  |
| 8        | seventy-seven thousand four hundred forty-one dollars (\$11,677,441) from federal Help America   |
| 9        | Vote Act (HAVA) funds as awarded by the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2020, P.L.  |
| 10       | 116-93, and the sum of two million three hundred thirty-five thousand four hundred eighty-eight  |
| 11       | dollars (\$2,335,488) as the required match from the State General Fund to the State Board of  |
| 12       | Elections, Budget Code 28025, for the 2020-2021 fiscal year. The State Board of Elections shall  |
| 13       | use these funds to:  |
| 14       | (1) Enhance and upgrade voting equipment and election auditing.  |
| 15       | (2) Improve the voter registration system and management.  |
| 16       | (3) Protect against cyber vulnerabilities.   |
| 17       | (4) Provide training and communication.  |
| 18       | (5) Assist with providing personal protective equipment and hiring temporary   |
| 19       | staff to process an increase in absentee ballot demands.   |
| 20       | <b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> Any federal HAVA funds unspent on June 30, 2021, shall revert to  |
| 21       | Budget Code 28025 and shall remain until appropriated by the General Assembly. Any remaining   |
| 22       | State match funds appropriated in this section shall revert in accordance with G.S. 143C-1-2.  |
| 23       | <b>SECTION 2.(a)</b> There is appropriated the sum of ten million nine hundred   |
| 24       | eighty-seven thousand two hundred ninety-five dollars (\$10,987,295) in federal Coronavirus Aid,<br>Deliaf, and Economic Security (CADES) Act, DL, 116,126, funds and the sum of two million |
| 25<br>26 | Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, P.L. 116-136, funds and the sum of two million  |
| 20<br>27 | one hundred twenty thousand four hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$2,120,497) as the required match from the State General Fund to the State Board of Elections, Budget Code 28025, for the    |

| 33       | <b>SECTION 2.(b)</b> Funds appropriated under this section shall be used in accordance   |
| 34       | with this section and the requirements and limitations set forth in the federal CARES Act.   |
| 35       | <b>SECTION 3.</b> Funds provided under this act may be used for special elections or   |
| 36       | applied to ballot recounts as permitted by federal law.  |
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## **General Assembly Of North Carolina**

1 **SECTION 4.** The State Board of Elections shall submit a report to the Joint 2 Legislative Elections Oversight Committee and the Fiscal Research Division on the use of the 3 funds appropriated under this act no later than February 28, 2021.

4 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the 2020 5 federal election cycle.
