Short Title:Funds for NCCU Programs.(Public)Sponsors:Representatives Hawkins and Alston (Primary Sponsors).Referred to:

1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT PROGRAMS FOR NORTH
3	CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1.(a) Transfer of Funds from Reserves to Relief Fund. – The State
6	Controller shall transfer one million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) for the
7	2019-2020 fiscal year from the Coronavirus Relief Reserve established in Section 2.1 of S.L.
8	2020-4 to the Coronavirus Relief Fund established in Section 2.2 of S.L. 2020-4.
9	<b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> Appropriation of Funds from Relief Fund. – There is appropriated
10	from the Coronavirus Relief Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of one
11	million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2019-2020
12	fiscal year to be allocated to North Carolina Central University (NCCU) to respond to the impacts
13	of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) on its students. Of the funds allocated to NCCU
14	pursuant to this section, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) shall be used to expand
15	online learning capacity for students and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)
16	shall be used to address food insecurity and basic needs for students who have been impacted by
17	COVID-19.
18 19	<b>SECTION 1.(c)</b> Reporting. – By September 30, 2020, NCCU shall report on the progress of the use of the appropriated funds received pursuant to this section to the Joint
19 20	Legislative Education Oversight Committee.
20	<b>SECTION 1.(d)</b> Limitations. – Of the funds appropriated from the Coronavirus
22	Relief Fund by this section, funds shall only be used for necessary eligible expenditures incurred
23	during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020. The funds
24	appropriated by this section shall not revert at the end of the 2019-2020 fiscal year but shall
25	remain available to expend until December 30, 2020.
26	<b>SECTION 2.</b> State Funds for BRITE and BBRI. – There is appropriated from the
27	General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six
28	million dollars (\$6,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be allocated to
29	North Carolina Central University. The funds shall be used as follows:
30	(1) The sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) shall be used to support
31	operations of the Biomanufacturing Research Institute and Technology
32	Enterprise (BRITE) at NCCU.
33	(2) The sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) shall be used for expenses for
34	the operation and repair of the Julius L. Chambers Biomedical Biotechnology
35	Research Institute (BBRI) at NCCU.



SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2020. The remainder of
this act becomes effective when this act becomes law.
