1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR OFFICIAL MAP ACT.
3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4 **SECTION 1.** Article 2E of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is repealed.
5 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 47-30(l) reads as rewritten:
6 "(l) This section does not apply to the registration of highway right-of-way plans provided
7 for in ~~G.S. 136-19.4 or G.S. 136-89.184~~, nor to the registration of roadway corridor official maps
8 provided for in ~~Article 2E of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes~~. G.S. 136-19.4."
9 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 160A-458.4 is repealed.
10 **SECTION 4.** Subsection (c) of G.S. 161-14 is repealed.
11 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to maps filed on
12 or after that date.
