The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Chapter 132 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new		
section to read:		
"§ 132-1.15. Personally identifiable records relating to county animal services.

relates to any of the following persons is not a public record as defined in G.S. 132-1:		
<u>(1</u>	An individual who has voluntarily surrendered ownership of an anim	ıal to an
	animal shelter.	
<u>(2</u>	An individual who has adopted a shelter animal or to whom a shelter	<u>r animal</u>
	has been placed through a foster program.	
<u>(b)</u> <u>W</u>	Then a county animal control service places animals with an animal	rescue
organization, the identity of the animal rescue organization is a public record as defined in		
<u>G.S. 132-1.</u>		
(c) Disclosure or nondisclosure of information that is not a public record under this		
section may be made in the county's discretion."		

SECTION 2. This act applies to Pitt County only.
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
