G.S. 130A-310.67 reads as rewritten: "§ 130A-310.67. Applicability. This Part applies to contaminated sites subject to remediation pursuant to any of the (a) following programs or requirements: The Inactive Hazardous Sites Response Act of 1987 under Part 3 of Article 9 (1)of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes, including voluntary actions under G.S. 130A-310.9 of that act, and rules promulgated pursuant to those statutes.
