A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year and the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, to reduce the current waitlist for Home and Community Care Block Grant services statewide.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
