## HOUSE BILL DRH30202-LGa-102

Short Title:Funds for Fort Fisher Aquarium.(Public)Sponsors:Representatives Davis and McElraft (Primary Sponsors).Referred to:

1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA
3	AQUARIUM AT FORT FISHER.
4	Whereas, the Aquarium at Fort Fisher is the most popular of the State's three
5	aquariums and the most visited attraction in southeastern North Carolina, having 493,603 visitors
6	in 2018; and
7	Whereas, annually, the Aquarium hosts more than 25,000 North Carolina school
8	students, reaches an additional 10,000 students through its Outreach programs with travelling
9	classrooms, and attracts over 120,000 participants to its educational programs, camps, and field
10	trips; and
11	Whereas, the Aquarium is an important resource for youth groups such as the 4-H,
12	scouts, YMCA, and Boys and Girls Clubs, all of which participate in camps and programs at the
13	facility; and
14	Whereas, the Aquarium also has a large and active volunteer force with over 505 local
15	volunteers who contributed nearly 32,000 hours of service during 2018, working in education
16	and animal care; and
17	Whereas, the Aquarium structure is over 40 years old, having had its last capital
18	renovation in 2002; and
19	Whereas, since 2002, the Aquarium has had more than 6.4 million visitors; and
20	Whereas, a refresh of the Aquarium's galleries and exhibits is needed to sustain the
21	Aquarium's popularity and to better serve its educational mission; and
22	Whereas, plans have been made for the renovation of the facility to include structural
23	upgrades, updated displays, redesigned classroom spaces, a new otter habitat, a new large feature
24	aquarium to display sand tiger sharks, and other improvements; and
25	Whereas, the expansion project is estimated to cost \$20 million, of which the
26	Aquarium plans to raise \$5 million through its capital campaign by the North Carolina Aquarium
27	Society and \$5 million through admission receipts; and
28	Whereas, State funds are needed to complete the project; Now, therefore,
29	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
30	<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
31	Natural and Cultural Resources, Division of North Carolina Aquariums, the sum of ten million
32	dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 2019-2020 fiscal year in nonrecurring funds for expansion of the
33	North Carolina Aquarium at Fort Fisher.
34	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
