1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT EXTENDING THE TERMS OF OFFICE FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS FOR
3	MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF BETHEL BEGINNING IN 2021.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Section 3 of the Charter of the Town of Bethel, being Chapter 20 of
6	the Private Laws of 1873-1874, as amended by Section 3 of Chapter 97 of the Private Laws of
7	1927, and Section 2 of Chapter 609 of the 1953 Session Laws reads as rewritten:
8	"Sec. 2. The Charter of the Town of Bethel is amended so as to provide that the officers of
9	said town the Town shall consist of a mayor and five commissioners who commissioners.
10	Beginning in 2021, a mayor and five commissioners shall hold office for terms of two-four years
11	each and until their successors are elected and qualified. On the first Monday in May, 1953, 2021
12	and biennially quadrennially thereafter, there shall be held a general municipal election for the
13	election of the mayor and commissioners of said town.the Town."
14	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
