S	ECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 609 of the Session Laws of 195	3, part of the
Charter of th	e Town of Bethel, being Chapter 20 of the Private Laws of 1873-1874	4, as amended
by Chapter 9	77 of the Private Laws of 1927, reads as rewritten:	
"Sec. 2. 7	The Charter of the Town of Bethel is amended so as to provide that t	the officers of
said town th	ne Town shall consist of a mayor and five commissioners who co	ommissioners.
Beginning in	2021, regular municipal elections shall be held in the Town every f	our years and
shall be cond	ducted in accordance with the general laws governing municipal elect	ions. In 2021,
and quadren	nially thereafter, a mayor and five commissioners shall hold office	be elected for
terms of two	years four years, and each and shall serve until their successors are	a successor is
duly elected	and qualified. On the first Monday in May, 1953, and biennially the	ereafter, there
shall be held	l a general municipal election for the election of the mayor and com	missioners of
said town."	•
