A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO DELAY THE REQUIRED DECERTIFICATION OF VOTING MACHINES IN ALAMANCE AND GUILFORD COUNTIES ONLY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Sections 30.8 and 30.9 of S.L. 2013-381, as amended by Section 6 of S.L. 2015-103 and Section 3.11 of S.L. 2018-13, and notwithstanding Section 5(c) of S.L. 2015-3, direct record electronic (DRE) voting systems that do not use paper ballots may be used in any election held before December 1, 2021, whether or not the direct record electronic voting system has been certified or decertified by the State Board of Elections in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. This act applies to Alamance and Guilford counties only.

SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
