A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE RATES FOR FOSTER CARE AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.(a)** G.S. 108A-49.1 reads as rewritten: "§ 108A-49.1. Foster care and adoption assistance payment rates. The maximum rates for State participation in the foster care assistance program are established on a graduated scale as follows: \$475.00 \$514.00 per child per month for children from birth through five (1) vears of age. \$581.00 \$654.00 per child per month for children six through 12 years of age. (2)

- \$634.00 \$698.00 per child per month for children at least 13 but less than 21 (3) years of age.
- The maximum rates for the State adoption assistance program are established consistent with the foster care rates as follows:
 - (1) \$475.00 \$514.00 per child per month for children from birth through five years of age.
 - \$581.00 \$654.00 per child per month for children six through 12 years of age. (2)
 - (3) \$634.00 \$698.00 per child per month for children at least 13 but less than 21 years of age.

SECTION 1.(b) G.S. 108A-49.1, as amended by subsection (a) of this section, reads as rewritten:

"§ 108A-49.1. Foster care and adoption assistance payment rates.

- The maximum rates for State participation in the foster care assistance program are established on a graduated scale as follows:
 - (1) \$475.00 \(\frac{\$553.00}{} \) per child per month for children from birth through five years of age.
 - \$581.00 \$727.00 per child per month for children six through 12 years of age. (2)
 - \$634.00 \$761.00 per child per month for children at least 13 but less than 21 (3) years of age.
- The maximum rates for the State adoption assistance program are established consistent with the foster care rates as follows:

- 1 (1) \$475.00 \(\frac{\$553.00}{\$553.00}\) per child per month for children from birth through five years of age.
 3 (2) \$\frac{\$581.00 \}{\$727.00}\) per child per month for children six through 12 years of age.
 4 (3) \$\frac{\$634.00 \}{\$761.00}\) per child per month for children at least 13 but less than 21 years of age.

 - **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Social Services, the sum of six million eight hundred sixty-eight thousand seven hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$6,868,758) for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to implement the foster care and adoption rate increases provided for in this act.
 - **SECTION 3.** Section 1(a) of this act becomes effective July 1, 2020. Section 1(b) of this act becomes effective July 1, 2021. Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2019. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
