Subsequent orders entered pursuant to Chapter 50 of the General Statutes related to 10 custody, child and spousal support, and possession of property and subsequent child support 11 orders entered pursuant to Chapter 110 of the General Statutes shall supersede like provisions in 12 13 an order issued pursuant to this Chapter."
