2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPILE A			
3	PUBLIC STREET INFORMATION DATABASE AND TO UPDATE THE SUBDIVISION			
4	ROADS MANUAL REGULARLY, AND TO EXEMPT CERTAIN PROPRIETARY			
5	DESIGN WORK OR WORK PRODUCT SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF			
6	TRANSPORTATION FROM PUBLIC RECORDS TEMPORARILY.			
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
8	SECTION 1. Article 2 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding			
9	a new section to read:			
10	" <u>§136-18.06. Public Street Information Database.</u>			
11	The Department shall compile a readily available "Public Street Information Database" and			
12	place it in operation on or before January 1, 2020. The information shall convey the status of			
13	roads within the State, and it shall be updated at least monthly, except as provided in subdivision			
14	(1) of this section. The data shall reside on any existing database system chosen by the			
15	Department for this purpose, including a geographic information system (GIS) mapping system.			
16	The system chosen shall convey clear and concise information regarding the status of roads to			
17	the public. The data shall be available to the public in either graphic or tabular format, or both.			
18	The status of roads to be conveyed shall be:			
19	(1) Federally owned, updated as often and with as much information as the State			
20	is provided from the federal government.			
21	(2) <u>State-maintained with a State road number assigned.</u>			
22	(3) State-owned with a State road number assigned."			
23	SECTION 2. Article 2 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding			
24	a new section to read:			
25	" <u>§ 136-18.07. Subdivision Roads Manual.</u>			
26	The Department shall update its Subdivision Roads Minimum Construction Standards			
27	Manual and any related pavement or other policies by July 1, 2020, and regularly thereafter, to			
28	accurately reflect current federal and State law and applicable judicial decisions. The Department			
29	shall report all updates to the Manual to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight			
30	Committee."			
31	SECTION 3. G.S. 132-1.2 reads as rewritten:			

32 "§ 132-1.2. Confidential information.

Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to require or authorize a public agency or its
subdivision to disclose any information that:
