2	AN ACT TO CREATE A RIGHT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO TESTIFY
3	BEFORE A GRAND JURY WHEN THE OFFICER MAY BE CRIMINALLY CHARGED
4	FOR A CRIME THAT ALLEGEDLY OCCURRED WHILE THE OFFICER WAS IN THE
5	PERFORMANCE OF THE OFFICER'S DUTIES.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-626 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
8	"(d1) In any matter where the grand jury is to consider a presentment or indictment of a
9	sworn law enforcement officer as a defendant for actions arising out of or in the performance of
10	the officer's duties as a sworn law enforcement officer, the district attorney shall notify the officer
11	by personal service 10 days prior to the grand jury session. The officer shall be notified that the
12	officer is entitled to appear before the grand jury and voluntarily testify or present evidence if the
13	officer so desires. If the officer elects to testify, the officer shall be called to testify after the
14	State's evidence has been presented to the grand jury."
15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to grand
16	jury proceedings on or after that date.
