SESSION LAW 2020-62 HOUSE BILL 694

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN AIRPORTS NORTH CAROLINA LEGACY AIRPORTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 6 of Chapter 63 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 63-59. Designation of legacy airports.

<u>The Department of Transportation shall name as a legacy airport any airport located in North</u> <u>Carolina that meets the following requirements: the airport (i) is owned and operated by a county</u> <u>or airport authority, (ii) was established as an airport or military facility before 1945, (iii) contains</u> <u>a terminal building or runway that was built before 1945, (iv) has an actively used runway that</u> <u>is at least 6,500 feet long, and (v) has contributed significantly to the development of aviation in</u> <u>this State.</u>"

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 25th day of June, 2020.
