10	including those who have been licensed in another country, must complete a course in alcohol	
11	and drug abuse awareness, unless the applicant is licensed in another state or has satisfactorily	
12	completed a Department of Education driver education course offered pursuant to Article 14 of	
13	Chapter 115C of the General Statutes.	
14	(b) Course Requirements. – The course shall be three hours in length, may be offered	
15	online or in person, and shall promote traffic safety and provide instruction on (i) the	
16	physiological and psychological consequences of the abuse of alcohol and other drugs, (ii) the
