HOUSE BILL DRH40375-LU-96

Short Title: Allow Curbside Voting for Caregivers. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives Dahle and Hunt (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT ALLOWING THE CAREGIVER OF A PERSON WHO MEETS THE
3 REQUIREMENTS FOR CURBSIDE VOTING TO ALSO VOTE USING CURBSIDE
4 VOTING.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163A-1140, as amended by Section 3.1(d) of S.L. 2018-144, reads
7 as rewritten:

8 "**§ 163A-1140. Curbside voting.**

9 (a) In any election or referendum, if any qualified voter is able to travel to the voting
10 place, but because of age or physical disability and physical barriers encountered at the voting
11 place is unable to enter the voting enclosure to vote in person without physical assistance, that
12 voter shall be allowed to vote either in the vehicle conveying that voter or in the immediate
13 proximity of the voting place. A qualified voter who is a caregiver transporting a voter voting
14 under this section shall be allowed to vote using curbside voting, provided only one caregiver
15 per vehicle shall be allowed to vote pursuant to this section.

17 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held
18 on or after that date.
