The 3 requirements of this subsection may be waived if the information required under this subsection 4 is already on file with the sheriff of the county in which the person resides. 5 Confidentiality. - Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, all information (e) 6 provided in accordance with this section is confidential and not a public record under G.S. 132-1. 7 The information provided in accordance with this section shall only be available (i) to a State or 8 local law enforcement agency upon request for the lawful performance of the agency's duties or 9 (ii) by court order. 10 Fee. – The sheriff shall charge for the sheriff's services upon receipt of a completed (f) 11 form in accordance with subsection (c) of this section a fee of five dollars (\$5.00) for each form 12 submitted. 13 Penalty. – A person who (i) fails to register a firearm as required under subsection (b) (g) 14 of this section or (ii) intentionally provides false information when registering an assault weapon 15 as required under subsection (a) of this section, is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor." 16 **SECTION 1.(b)** The State Bureau of Investigation, in consultation with the North 17 Carolina Sheriffs' Association, shall establish forms to be used statewide by persons registering assault weapons in accordance with G.S. 14-409.41, as enacted by subsection (a) of this section. 18 19 SECTION 1.(c) Notwithstanding the five-day requirement set forth in 20 G.S. 14-409.41(a), as enacted by subsection (a) of this section, a person who owns and possesses 21 an assault weapon as of the effective date of this section shall register the assault weapon in 22 accordance with the requirements of G.S. 14-409.41 no later than 90 days from the effective date 23 of this section. 24 **SECTION 1.(d)** Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, this 25 section becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to assault weapons obtained on or after 26 that date. 27 28 PART II. REPORT LOST OR STOLEN FIREARMS 29 **SECTION 2.(a)** Article 53A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by 30 adding a new section to read: 31 "§ 14-409.13. Report of loss or theft of firearm. Any owner of a firearm as defined in G.S. 14-408.1(a) shall report the loss or theft of 32 (a) 33 the firearm within 48 hours after the discovery of the loss or theft to either (i) the local law 34 enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the location where the loss or theft of the firearm 35 occurred or (ii) the State Bureau of Investigation. 36 A violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor; however, a second or subsequent (b) 37 violation of this section is a Class I felony." 38 SECTION 2.(b) This section becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to 39 offenses committed on or after that date. 40 41 **PART III. EFFECTIVE DATE** 42 **SECTION 3.** Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective December 1,

43 2019.
