A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW AUTHORIZATION FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO REPORT THREATS OF VIOLENCE UPON ALLEGATIONS FROM A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS DURING THE COURSE OF TREATMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 1A of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 90-21.10A. Authorization to report threat of violence.

- (a) Any health care provider, as defined in G.S. 90-21.11, licensed to practice medicine in this State who, as a result of providing health services to a minor, has cause to suspect an individual has communicated a threat of violence against the public or against an individual, is authorized to notify all of the following:
 - (1) The law enforcement agency with jurisdiction over the location where the threat of violence exists or where the communication of a threat is directed.
 - (2) If the threat occurred in or is directed at a school, the principal of the school or the superintendent of the local school administrative unit where the school is located.
- (b) Any health care provider, as defined in G.S. 90-21.11, who makes a notification in good faith under this section shall have immunity from any liability, civil or criminal, that might otherwise be incurred or imposed as the result of the making of such notification."
- **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2019, and applies to any information received by a health care provider on or after that date.
