AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EXTEND U.S. ROUTE 311 IN WINSTON-SALEM.

11 12 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Transportation the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year to be allocated to the City of Winston-Salem for the purpose of extending U.S. Route 311 from Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive through 7th Street to Highland Avenue in accordance with the City of Winston-Salem "East End Master Plan." For any amount allocated pursuant to this section, the Department shall require matching funds in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00) by the city in non-State funds for every three dollars (\$3.00) in State funds allocated.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
