5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 18B-600(e3) reads as rewritten:		
6	"(e3) Small Town Mixed Beverage Elections. – A town may hold a mixed beverage election		
7	if the town (i) has at least 200 registered voters and voters, is located in a county bordering the		
8	Neuse River and Pamlico Sound that has not approved the sale of mixed beverages beverages,		
9	and that county has only one city that has approved the sale of mixed beverages. beverages or		
10	(ii) has at least 200 registered voters, has a total area of less than one square mile, operates an		
11	ABC store, a	nd is located in a county that has at least three cities that have approved the	e sale of
12	mixed beverages. Provided, that if a town that qualifies for an election under this subsection		
13	approves the	sale of mixed beverages, mixed beverages permittees in the town may p	ourchase
14	liquor from th	he ABC store designated by any local ABC board in any other city that has a	pproved
15	the sale of mi	ixed beverages."	
16	SI	ECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
