

6	PART I. INTRODUCTION AND TITLE OF ACT
7	
8	INTRODUCTION
9	SECTION 1.1. The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts
10	necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget in
1	accordance with the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General Statutes. Savings shall be
12	effected where the total amounts appropriated are not required to perform these services and
13	accomplish these purposes, and the savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of each
14	fiscal year, except as otherwise provided by G.S. 143C-1-2(b).

16	TITLE OF ACT
17	SECTION 1.2. This act shall be known as the "Current Operations Appropriations
18	Act of 2019."

23	SECTION 2. Appropriations from the General Fund of the State for the maintenance

30	SECTION 3. Appropriations from the State Highway Fund for the maintenance and

14	fiscal year of the biennium ending June 30, 2021, in accordance with the provisions of this act.

19 20	SECTION 6.1. The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General
20 21	Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act by reference.

23	MOST TEXT APPLIES ONLY TO THE 2019-2021 FISCAL BIENNIUM
23 24	SECTION 6.2. Except for statutory changes or other provisions that clearly indicate
25	an intention to have effects beyond the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium, the textual provisions of this
26	act apply only to funds appropriated for, and activities occurring during, the 2019-2021 fiscal
27	biennium.

29	EFFECT OF HEADINGS
30	SECTION 6.3. The headings to the parts and sections of this act are a convenience
31	to the reader and are for reference only. The headings do not expand, limit, or define the text of
32	this act, except for effective dates referring to a part.
33	
34	SEVERABILITY CLAUSE
35	SECTION 6.4. If any section or provision of this act is declared unconstitutional or
36	invalid by the courts, it does not affect the validity of this act as a whole or any part other than
37	the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.
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39	EFFECTIVE DATE
40	SECTION 6.5. Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective July 1,
41	2019.
