## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## 2 AN ACT TO ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO DISCLOSE OR RELEASE 3 RECORDINGS PURPOSES SUSPECT IDENTIFICATION FOR OF OR 4 APPREHENSION OR TO LOCATE A MISSING OR ABDUCTED PERSON.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 132-1.4A(h) reads as rewritten:

7 Release of Recordings; Law Enforcement Purposes. - Notwithstanding the "(h) 8 requirements of subsections (c), (f), and (g) of this section, a custodial law enforcement agency 9 shall disclose or release a recording to a district attorney (i) for review of potential criminal charges, (ii) in order to comply with discovery requirements in a criminal prosecution, (iii) for 10 use in criminal proceedings in district court, or (iv) for any other law enforcement purpose, and 11 may disclose or release a recording for any of the following purposes: 12 13

- For law enforcement training purposes. (1)

- Within the custodial law enforcement agency for any administrative, training, (2)or law enforcement purpose.
  - To another law enforcement agency for law enforcement purposes. (3)
- 17 For suspect identification or apprehension. (4)
- To locate a missing or abducted person." 18 (5)
- **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 19
