SECTION 2. G.S. 15A-534.1 is amended by adding a new subsection t	to read:
"(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, at the initial appearance of	f a defendant
immediately following the defendant's arrest, a judicial official authorized by this	Article to set
conditions of pretrial release may order that the defendant have no contact with the al	lleged victim
of the crime while the defendant awaits the determination of pretrial release condition	ons pursuant
to subsections (a) and (b) "
