A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, TO PROVIDE A GRANT-IN-AID TO BRIDGE TO RECOVERY, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT AND RECOVERY SERVICES IN THE CITY OF MONROE.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, to provide a grant-in-aid to Bridge to Recovery, Inc., a nonprofit corporation located in Monroe, North Carolina. Bridge to Recovery, Inc., shall not use these funds for any purpose other than to provide treatment and recovery services to individuals with substance use disorders.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
